NJSGL Spring Captain's Meeting Minutes

- 1) Meeting was called to order at 10:15 with President Joe Harkay presiding.
- 2) Roll Call was conducted, all 13 teams were represented.

OLD BUSINESS

- 3) Minutes of the November 11, 2011 meeting were read by Secretary Tom Coughlin and were accepted as read.
- 4) Treasurer's Report was read by John Martinez. The opening balance was \$2,102.40, total income was \$12,942.00, total expenses were \$14,200.08, and ending balance was \$844.32. After a lengthily discussion concerning expenditures, the report was accepted.
- 5) President Harkay introduced the new captain from Green Knoll, Bob Daily. The new co-captain from Charleston Springs, Jim Panepinto, was unable to attend.
- 6) Secretary Coughlin discussed the new league web-site, which is available to all league members, asked the captains to furnish any roster changes, and also asked if any courses have been re-rated or changed from last year.
- 7) A tabled motion from the prior meeting submitted by Randy Scott was re-introduced. The motion concerned the redefining of the Conditions Governing Competition, Article 8 (d)... Championship Match Tiebreaker; the first tiebreaker is to be the total net strokes, the second tiebreaker will be an actual two-man sudden death playoff starting at the first hole. The respective Captain's will each select a representative to compete. Their net handicaps are to be applied. The motion was unanimously passed. This change is applicable for both the semi-final and final matches.

NEW BUSINESS

- 8) Randy Scott proposed to require the home team captain provide a paper copy of the match roster when the scorecards are distributed. The motion was passed by a hand vote.
- 9) Tom Coughlin proposed to have all team matches result in a total of 30 points. If there is an individual match with a dual forfeit, each team will be awarded 1 ½ points. This motion passed by a hand vote.
- 10) Tom Coughlin led a discussion to clarify or change the current rules concerning new player handicaps. It was determined that many captains were not properly interpreting the rules in their calculations. Different methods were offered to simplify the calculations, but after Randy Scott's explanation of the correct procedure, George Skorinko proposed we continue with the current method. The motion passed by a hand

vote. Tom Coughlin will detail all the steps in the calculations and post it on the web-site.

- 11) Joe Harkay announced the Memorial Tournament will be held on Monday, July 2nd at 1:00 pm. This year we will be playing on the Mercer Oaks West Course. The cost has been increased the \$110 this year. Joe is attempting to have Golfsmith furnish a \$10 gift certificate to all players. A copy of the flyer is on the web-site and further announcements concerning the tournament will be posted there. All captains were asked to try and maximize participation.
- 12) Joe Harkay announced that the Fall Captain's Meeting will be held on Friday, November 9th, 2012 at the Cambridge Inn in Spotswood. Spooky Brook will be hosting.
- 13) The meeting was adjourned at 12:05 pm.
